Place one double-spaced blank line between the paper title and the author names. Center author names on their own line. If there are two authors, use the word “ and ” between authors; if there are three or more authors, place a comma between author names and use the word “ and ” before the final author name. The sixth edition provides explicit rules for direct quotations and states that you must credit the source when “ paraphrasing, quoting an author directly, or describing an idea that influenced your work ” (p. 170). If the quotation is less than 40 words, incorporate the quotation

Elements of the reference. Name of author(s) or the institution responsible, use & for multiple authors. (Year of publication). Title and subtitle of publication – italicised, Name of institution, Location of institution.. In-text reference

Lecture notes and slides - APA 6th referencing style ...

The publication manual shows an Author Note as an optional item on the title page. It appears in the lower half of the page and contains information about the authors, their institutional affiliations, or how the article was written. It is not needed for student papers unless an instructor asks for it. If this page differs from your APA Manual

Student Paper in APA Style: Sample Title Page

For 6 or more authors, you usually cite the first author, and then abbreviate with "et al.": Ellenbogen et al. (2013) suggests that microscopic fissures might be responsible for the damage. The damage could have been caused by microscopic fissures (Ellenbogen et al., 2013).

Websites - APA Style (6th Edition) Citation Guide ...

The APA citation style (6th Edition) is a parenthetical author-date style, so you need to put the author ' s last name and the publishing date into parentheses wherever another source is used in the narrative. The APA format consists of in-text citations and a reference list, along with guidelines for formatting the paper itself.

The author (s) name (s) should be written as: Surname (year, page number) or (Surname, year, page number) for a direct quote. Cite the names of the authors in the order they appear. Do not include suffixes, e.g. Dr or Jr. For foreign names, capitalise and spell the name just as it appears in the article you're citing.
