In the sense of the "art of the general", which included several subsets of skills including military tactics, siegecraft, logistics etc., the term came into use in the 6th century ...

Strategy was borne out of military conflicts and the use of a superior strategy enabled one warring party to defeat another. Indeed, the word strategy has its roots in warfare. The Greek verb strategos means “ army leader ” and the idea of stratego (from which we get the word strategy) refers to defeating an enemy by effectively using resources (Bracker, 1980).

The word “ strategy ” is derived from the Greek word “ stratēgos ” ; stratus (meaning army) and “ ago ” (meaning leading/moving). Strategy is an action that managers take to attain one or more of the organization 's goals.
