Complementary medicine uses different methods to promote health. Some complementary medicines include: Massage therapy; Yoga; Aromatherapy (using the scents of herbs and plant oils) Some doctors will use a combination of traditional and complementary medicine.

The Tension Between Traditional and Western Medicine. Traditional and alternative medicine are ubiquitous. Forty percent of American adults use at least one form of alternative medicine. The WHO reports that traditional medicine constitutes around half of health care utilization in China and up to 80 percent of utilization in Sub-Saharan Africa.
